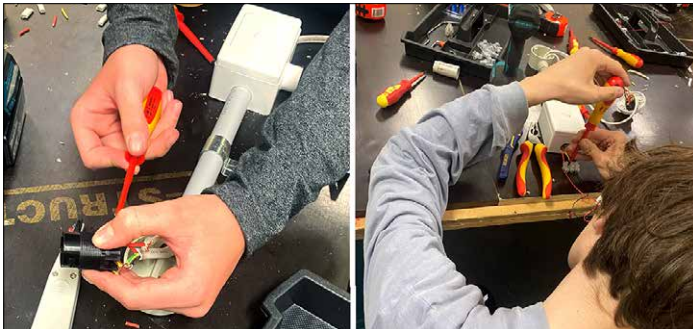

PLANNED EXPERIENCES

- perform electrical work on boards

- use plumbing hand and power tools
- experience joining methods with PVC stormwater piping
- perform basic levelling, trenching and setting up string lines
